A record of educational intent or declaration of major must be auditable and stored within the Student Information System. FTE for courses ending after August 20 are included in the following semester's report.

**Note:** Student FTE from undergraduate nursing courses and science-based nursing prerequisites/requirements will be added to the annual average FTE totals from the fall and spring semesters of the subsequent academic year at each institution for the purposes of computing state supported budgets.
